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Operation Threshold Success Story —

We had a client contact us looking for assistance with housing. She was living in transitional housing and would soon need to find permanent housing. She was having trouble finding housing because of her rental history. In addition, she had medical needs that would require her to have a ground floor unit. Our staff helped her identify potential housing opportunities. She was able to find a rental unit and our staff helped her apply to the Embrace lowa program for funds to assist her with her rental deposit. Staff also helped her apply for Section 8 housing assistance and, once she was in her new apartment, helped her apply for energy assistance.

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
