# Strategic Framework



**Review Timeline:** Data will be collected by program staff on an ongoing basis. Each program will be reviewed by applicable program managers and department directors. Staff will review Community Assessment data, including customer satisfaction data. Information gathered will be used to update the Strategic Framework to address new or emerging community and/or client needs. The Strategic Framework, including essential management and service delivery processes, will be reviewed twice each fiscal year by the Management Team and Board of Directors. Generally reviews will occur each January and May. Updates will be made to pertinent portions of the Framework as needed.

Throughout the year, customer satisfaction surveys will be conducted. Surveys will be reviewed quarterly by program and management staff. Results will be presented to the Board of Directors twice each year.

The Strategic Framework as whole will be reviewed and updated on a regular basis. The next comprehensive review/updates for 2022 will occur in January and May 2022.

    - Veterans will receive emergency housing assistance.
    - Households impacted by COVID-19 will receive crisis assistance.

## Result Area: Agency



### Goals for 2022:

- 1. Operation Threshold will continue to develop highly-skilled, well-informed community action professionals and promote leadership inside and outside the agency.**

All staff will receive annual training related to community action as well as training related to their specific position, including but not limited to topics such as cultural competency, client confidentiality, abuse reporting, ROMA, etc.
- 2. Operation Threshold will coordinate its services internally to ensure all customers receive high quality services.**
  - Operation Threshold staff will continue to evaluate programs and service delivery to ensure continued provision of high quality services.
  - Operation Threshold will establish a system for customer feedback.
- 3. Operation Threshold will expand and diversify its resource base to provide a more solid foundation to achieve its mission.**

Operation Threshold will work to reduce the proportion of its revenue that comes from government grants.
